

In 2012 there were an estimated 54,000 wild koalas in NSW. By 2016 the NSW Chief Scientist reported only 36,000 koalas were left.

Then 10,000 koalas perished during the 2019/20 bushfires and thousands of hectares of koala habitat were destroyed.

A 2020 NSW parliamentary inquiry found that **NSW** koalas will become extinct by 2050 if urgent action is not taken to protect their habitat.

Koalas are now listed as an Endangered Species in NSW, Queensland and the ACT.

The **Great Koala National Park** would add 175,000 ha of public native forest (State Forests) to the existing reserve system, creating a 315,000 ha network of protected koala habitat on public lands on the NSW mid north coast. It would protect approximately 20% of NSW remaining wild koalas.

The Great Koala National Park would deliver jobs and economic growth, tourism and recreational opportunities, protect biodiversity, build carbon capture and storage and deliver clean water.

Did you know?

- Habitat loss is the key threat to koala survival.
- The Great Koala National Park proposal involves only 8.7% of the NSW public native forest estate. It does not include private land or public plantations.
- Public native forest logging in NSW makes an annual \$10-20 million loss and is propped up from the NSW public purse each year.
- The NSW public plantation sector is growing, thriving and profitable.
- We support a job for job guarantee for directly affected native forest timber workers.
- Polls show the community wants The Great Koala National Park.
- According to a University of Newcastle report (2021), over a 15 year period, the GKNP would create 9,800 regional jobs generating \$330m in wages and \$273m in capital and operating expenditure. It would also generate \$412 million in tourism spending.
